Description

Dimensions of the stone: 3,4 x 2,3 x 1,1 m, circumference 9,3 m. Red large-grained granite.

Narrative

Widely-known stone, described in many legends and stories. At the beginning of the Northern War it is said that the Russian Tsar Peter I and the King of Poland - Augustus II the Strong had had breakfast and had wrestled on the stone. According to another story the stone had been carried in a cart by the Devil.
